Review Process and Scoring Card

The SEPONL Special Project Grant Committee recommends the project to the SEPONL Executive Board for their final approval.

All submitted proposals will undergo a blind review by board members. The grant award recipient will be selected based on consideration of eligibility and merit of the research proposal.

Awards will be granted based on the following criteria:

- 1. Merit of the proposal*
- 2. Overall impact of the proposed research study on the defined purpose*
- 3. Extent to which the project supports nursing administration, evidence-based practice and/or leadership.*
- 4. Applicability of the project to other organizations.*
- 5. Is the support (budget) requested justified to the proposed research?*

Priority is given to research work that advances nursing leadership.
